Academic Excellence

It is well said, " WORK HARD IN SILENCE; LET SUCCESS MAKE THE NOISE".

The school driven by its mission, measures its success by its students rising high in their spheres, leading their way to the top colleges and Universities, thus maintaining its repute as 'the Hallmark in Education'. Yet another academic year ended on a happy note - the 9th successive batch of class X with 100% pass percentage 24 students scored perfect 10 CGPA. The 7th batch in class XII CBSE Board Examination with registration of 105 students, 94 children got distinction with 99 marks as highest in Chemistry, Mathematics, Physical Education and Painting, 97 as highest in Physics, Psychology & Business Studies, 96 in Economics , English, Biology, Accountancy and Computer Science.

Star performer of the school, **Ankur Sharma**, secured 97.6% in science stream to be the second city topper. He along with Shashank is presently studying in IIT, Delhi.

Our **11 students** are placed in various **IIT's** out of 23 who had cleared IITJEE examination.

Ira Puranik gave exemplary performance in commerce with 95%.

Kumar Shashwat, Arpan Vishnoi, Ankur Sharma and Mihir Sirohi have been awarded Certificate of Merit by CBSE, for their exemplary Academic performance & for being among the top .1% of successful students in AISSE . These children surely deserve a huge round of applause.

School for **past years has been holding inhouse Multiple Intelligence & Adventure Camp** for Primary & Middle School.

Connecting across the boundaries students were given International exposure through online exchange, Connecting Classroom programs by British Council Taking forward our '**Educational Exchange Program**' 4 member delegation visited **Ellery Park School, Liverpool & Chater Junior School, Watford** in U.K. Ms. Margaret Morris, Mr. Mc.Peter, Ms. Kim Olyctt, Head Teacher, Deputy Head Teacher of respective schools visited our school in February this year.

6 students went to **France** under **Cultural Exchange Program** in collaboration with French Embassy.

We have focused sessions and workshops for Life skills, in collaboration with **Max** super specialty and **Expressions India** on special topics like Gender Sensitivity, Drug Abuse, Team building, Child Development & Adolescence. We also invite resource people to conduct intensive sessions on special topics including disaster management, first aid and health education, traffic rules, Social responsibilities, environmental studies, fire prevention, leadership skills, career planning and many more.

Our students are exposed to numerous **National and International level Assessments** which include ASSET, ACER, Olympiads, University of New South Wales, Australia, Cambridge University and NTSE and have given winning performance.

Anubhav Singh, Darshan Narayanan, Ritwik Shekhar, Shivang Gupta & Shubhank Saxena qualified the 1st level of NTSE. **Kislay Raj** along with **Sparsh Bansal** won scholarship on qualifying both levels of the same.

Pranjal Rai along with **Prisha Rawat** of class III became the Science State Topper.

Himani and **Sanjeevani** of XIth class secured first place in National Psycholampiad where 30 schools participated.

Basketball court is vibrant throughout the year as the school hosted Inter State Basketball Tournament in June and also, for the third consecutive year, also hosted **InterSchool Basketball Tournament** under the aegis of ‘**Sahodaya Schools Complex, Ghaziabad** on October 9th & 10th this year .

Our students performed exceptionally in most of the competitions but to cut it short I would like to highlight a few of them.
