

ANNUAL REPORT 2016

The school driven by its philosophy of **Empower, Enthuse & Excel** measures its success by its students escalating achievements in their respective spheres, leading their way to the top colleges and Universities, thus maintaining its reputation as 'the Hallmark in Education'. Yet another academic year ended on a happy note. We are proud to share that our students of class X gave 100% pass result under the CCE Program with 50 students scoring a perfect 10 CGPA score. Furthermore out of the 83 students registered for Class XII CBSE Board Examination, 76 children got distinction. The range being between 98-100 has led to a rise in the average percentage of the school score.

Star performer of the school, Hitesh Agarwal, secured 95.5% in Science stream and is presently studying in IIT, Delhi along with **Kislay Raj** and **Darshan S. Narayan**, his batch mates.

8 of our students are placed in various IIT's out of 23 who had cleared IIT JEE. **Vaishnavi Sachdeva & Prarthana Garg** gave exemplary performance in Commerce and Humanities with 94.5% respectively.

Hard work of these children deserves a huge round of applause.
