Class Xth achieved 100% result with 50 students scoring perfect 10 CGPA.

our students of class XII who appeared for the 2016 - 17 AISSCE Examination performed exceptionally well, with 9 students securing 100in various subjects. The school topper Rhythm Gupta secured 97% closely followed by Tushar Vohra & Aastha Bisht at 96.5%. This result has been the best with the school aggregate scaling up to all time high of 89%.
