### Kindly Note:

- For Term-II examination, question papers shall be set from the whole syllabus, strictly as per CBSE guideline.
- Promotion is granted on the basis of the performance of the student during the entire session.
- A student must secure at least 33% in all the subjects individually and in aggregate in theory as well as practical subject separately for fulfilling the pass criteria.
- In case the student has secured less than 33% in one subject only and 33% and more in all other subjects in theory and practical examination separately, student will be eligible for 'Compartment' Examination.
- In case the student has secured less than 33% in two or more subjects, he/she will not be eligible for 'Compartment' Examination and will be detained in the same class.
- The student must get minimum 'D' grade in Work Education.
- The Student must have a minimum of 75% attendance to be eligible to appear in final Examination.
- It is mandatory for the student to appear in Periodic Tests and Term End Examination.
- No retest of any kind will be conducted if a student is absent on the day of examination.
- If any exam is postponed / preponed, it is mandatory for all to abide by school instructions. No application for a retest / re-exam will be entertained.
- The Medical certificate in case of medical leave should be submitted to the class teacher within a week of commencement of Exam.
